





- Result: indoor is still important, but more savings outdoors












Map highlights neighborhoods burdened by socioeconomic stressors (yellow/orange) Equity: Why Traditional Conservation Programs Don't Always Work

ЕВМИД

- Traditional rebates have a high up-front cost
- Landscape transformation: high cost, strict eligibility requirements
- DIY Programs require time and resources
- Many low-income customers are renters who don't have an account with us
- Language barriers
- Lack of trust in public agencies





Agency Challenges




- Prop 218 restrictions
- Making materials available in multiple languages
- Direct install programs have higher cost, greater risk
- Designing programs that truly support customers in multi-family residential settings (apartments, condos)
